FEEDING DIRECTIONS

Feed as part of a total mixed ration. Consult the following chart for usage.

TYPE OF ANIMAL	POUNDS PER HEAD PER DAY
Cattle (Beef)	2 - 8
Calves (Beef)	1 - 2

In all cases, provide plenty of fresh, clean water, adequate forage, and a source of vitamins and minerals. For further feeding directions, consult your supplier or nutritionist.
